QUICK FACTS

LA County new retail light vehicle registrations increased 2.4% during the first ten months of this versus year earlier. U.S. market was up 4.8%.

Seven brands had increases of greater than 14% so far this year: Acura, Genesis, Lucid, Cadillac, Land Rover, Mercedes-Benz, and Toyota (see page 3).


Tesla Model Y, Model 3, Toyota Camry, Toyota RAV4, and Honda Civic were top-selling models (see page 4).






Percent Change in Registrations YTD '25 thru October vs. Year Earlier (Top 30 selling brands)





County and U.S. Market Share YTD '25 thru October (Top 20 selling brands in county)








Market Share for Japanese, Domestic, European, and Other Asian Brands


